
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



DETAIL OF IN-KIND DONATION:

The project was implemented in partnership with The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, exemplifying the impact of collaborative efforts.



With each act of support, we strive to nurture not only bodies but also spirits, making sure that children are seen, valued, and cared for quietly, compassionately, and with intention.






AT DISTRICT THARPARKAR




Hisaar Foundation built 29 rehab wells, restoring clean water access for 875 families in a severely water-stressed region.
