Water Conservation at Schools

SCHOOL WATER CONSERVATION & MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

- 1. **Appoint** a person in school to take on water conservation responsibilities and ensure them
- 2. **Institute** daily end of the day checking, of all water fixtures to ensure they are closed tight and there is no leakage
- 3. **Ensure** regular maintenance and repair of all water infrastructure
- 4. **Institute** periodic water audits
- 5. Involve school children in water audits and water conservation behavior
- 6. Send Household Water Conservation Guidelines home with children
- 7. **Arrange** for reuse of water harvested from the atmosphere within the school

CONSERVING WATER IN WORK AREAS & KITCHEN / CANTEEN AREAS

- 1. Close all taps tightly after use
- 2. Soak and wash utensils using two sinks rather than directly under the tap



CONSERVING WATER IN GARDEN/YARD/PLAYGROUND **SPACES**

- 1. Use hand held watering can or spray and do not use pipe or hose
- 2. Water garden in morning or evening, when it is cooler and water is more easily absorbed
- 3. Use a refillable water bottle. At the end of the day, any leftover water can be poured onto the garden

CONSERVING WATER IN BATHROOM

- 1. Do not keep tap running while washing, put signs to remind students to do the same
- 2. Replace single-flush toilets with dual-flush toilets
